Costs for Registration:

Early Registration: An initial deposit of 50 AED -Applicable from the 1st of September to the 30th of September 2021.

Normal Registration: An initial deposit of AED 100 -Applicable from the 1st of October and ends on the 31st of October 2021.

Late Registration: An initial deposit of AED 150 -Applicable from the 1st of November and ends on the 30th of November 2021.

Note: We are monitoring the situation with COVID-19 and are consistently communicating with our faculty advisers to ensure that AUSMUN 2022 takes place in accordance with the respected guidelines and safety precautions. However, if the conference took place on campus then an additional fee of AED 100 will apply to the deposited amount.

Deadlines: Name changes and name amendments will not be permitted after 30th of November 2021. No applications will be accepted after the 30th of November 2021.

General Information: Schools are not permitted to bring their own photographers nor observers. During the conference, strict COVID 19 restrictions shall be imposed, including social distancing, wearing masks, regular sanitizing, and restricted gathering. Both delegates and faculty advisors must present valid COVID-19 test results at entry.
